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
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# A. To remove the reset switch from an Inspiration Ventilator follow these steps.

- 1. Disconnect AC power from the ventilator.
- 2. Disconnect the internal batteries.
- 3. Remove the Front Enclosure.
- 4. With a pair of small, needle-nosed pliers, carefully remove the power reset switch from the Powerboard.



- B. Once the reset switch has been removed follow these steps.
- 5. Re-install the Front Enclosure.
- 6. Reconnect the internal batteries
- 7. Reconnect AC Power.
- 8. Turn the ventilator on. Verify that the ventilator passes the Power On Self Tests and runs normally.
