



“We are the future generation of Lebanon and we want to protect Lebanon by first protecting ourselves”, said Amin and Dany, the two 4 year-old boys dressed in the Lebanese Army outfit on the occasion of the Polio Vaccination Recreation Day organized at Ch’him Educational Hall on Thursday, 20th August, 2014, which happened simultaneous to the celebration of Lebanon’s Independence Day.

This heart-warming expression stated by these two boys was very stirring and showed our young generation’s concern, strong will & sense of responsibility they have to protect Lebanon!

During this event, 958 children under the age of 5 years old were vaccinated against polio, attending from schools located in the region of ‘Iqlim Kharoub’. Out of a total of 42 private and public schools in this region, 17 schools participated, and out of 15 public schools, 8 schools attended the event.

The event did not only include free polio vaccination for children, it also included entertainment activities, including: puppet shows, musical plays and songs.
